The Coventry Grid discusses the similarities and differences between children on the autism spectrum and children with attachment problems and their response to interventions. The child's response to therapeutic interventions and strategies, can reveal whether or not the child's issues are ASD or attachment related, or both.

So then I discovered the Coventry Grid, and suddenly it all makes sense. I've seen attachment disorders in some small children I've worked with, and what's hugely evident is how fixated they get on keeping some things the same that also shows up in ASD.
