Lake Crescent offers many hiking trails, some involve climbing the surrounding mountains and others will have you exploring the lowland forests and creeks. Marymere Falls Hiking Trail The self-guided Marymere Falls Hiking Trail is 3/4 of a mile from the Storm King Ranger Station.

Hiking at Lake Crescent Lodge | Olympic National Park ...

Crystal clear and ice cold, Lake Crescent is a beautiful lake nestled in the foothills of the Olympic mountains. Because of its unique location and ecology, Lake Crescent is free of nitrogen and algae, making for extremely clear waters. And at over 600 feet deep, carved into the valley floor by glaciers, it is home to unique fish species.

Crescent Lake The distance and vertical gain on a visit to Crescent Lake will ensure solitude. This gem of a lake is tucked in a beautiful hanging valley underneath the ridge that continues to Mount Howard, the highest peak on Nason Ridge.

A stunning glacier-fed lake. Lake Crescent is one of the most multi-faceted outdoors destinations in Washington State. At the northern edge of Olympic National park, just 25 minutes West of Port Angeles, Lake Crescent offers hiking, camping, lodging, kayaking, you name it.

We drove from hurricane ridge to crescent lake for the hike through old growth Forrest and to the water fall. The track is easy about a three mile round trip, it gets steep as you approach the falls, but worth the effort.

Crescent Lake Hiking Trail (Kenai) - 2020 All You Need to ...

Three miles south of Monroe, this oxbow lake near the Snoqualmie River provides bird habitat and a little bit of trail wandering. The Crescent Lake unit, managed by the Washington Department of Fish and Wildlife also contains a 25-acre marsh and about 200 acres of deciduous trees -- so it's an excellent diversion in the autumn.

Lake Crescent has several hiking trails, some of which climb the surrounding mountains, and others that explore the lowland forests and creeks. The hike to Marymere Falls by way of the Barnes Creek trail, is a favorite, as is the Spruce Railroad trail that runs along the north shore.

Visiting Lake Crescent - Olympic National Park (U.S ...

Lake Crescent, a cold, clear, glacially-carved lake, owes its existence to ice. Its azure depths, which plummet to 624 feet, were gouged by huge ice sheets thousands of years ago. As the ice retreated, it left behind a steep valley that filled with the clear blue waters of Lake Crescent. The lake's waters have very little nitrogen.

Along Lake Crescent—Washington State's second deepest lake—no trip to the area is complete without a hike to Devils Punchbowl, Marymere Falls, and the top of Mount Storm King. These three hikes are quintessential to getting a feel for the Lake Crescent region.

Marymere Falls is but a quick walk from Lake Crescent Lodge to the Storm King Ranger Station which, when open, offers information about the history of the area and displays historic pictures. From the ranger station, a 0.75-mile jaunt will deliver you along a wide, flat, well-marked trail to the impressive 90-foot falls.

Group Hike: Spruce Railroad Trail, Lake Crescent The Spruce Railroad Trail is a popular destination along Lake Crescent. This hike is more difficult than previous group hikes, so please read the trail guide carefully. We will be hiking to Devils Punchbowl, with the option of continuing on the trail if there is a group who wants to go further.

Tucked away at the west end of Lake Crescent, Fairholme Campground is a fairly large campground ideally situated near the water and with direct access to Fairholme Beach. While none of the 88 sites have hookups, this campground gets plenty of RV traffic (maximum recommended length is 21 feet).

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
